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Numerous publications and reports from countries, the UN, NGOs and the media in recent years have highlighted the extensive and wide-ranging violations and discrimination that are experienced by people with mental health conditions and psychosocial disabilities experience around the world. The WHO QualityRights initiative was born out of an urgent need to address these violations and discrimination so entrenched in the area of mental health and to push forward recovery and human rights-based approach in mental health in countries everywhere. This presentation will highlight the different areas of action being undertaken as part of the initiative to promote human rights in mental health and describe the different QualityRights materials and tools that have been developed to support countries in these efforts including the new QualityRights e-training on Mental Health, Recovery and Inclusion, launched globally by WHO's Director General in 2022.
